INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION & CAMPUS INTERVIEW

Thus, PCON succeeded in witnessing an international recruitment interview (first time ever) at the campus and 11 students of 2019 B.Sc. nursing batch were selected for job in the UK.

COLLABORATION WITH NGO (BODHANA)



WORLD MALARIA DAY




WORLD HYPERTENSION DAY






WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY








NATIONAL READING DAY


WORLD VITILIGO DAY


